

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Quick Facts / FAQ

What's changing?

- Sold listings are publicly displayed immediately on Realtor.ca beginning April 10.
- Sale prices become available on REALTOR.ca 30 days after the sale has closed.
- Previously, sale prices were only displayed in the sales history and only one year after closing.

What does "Price Pending" mean?

• Indicates the sale has not closed yet and the sale price is not shown.

What does "Price Unavailable" mean?

• Indicates the sold price data is not available or the seller has opted out of publicly displaying the sale price.

Closed sales and listed price:

• Closed sales will not show the original listed price publicly, only the final sale price after 30 days. Pending sales will show the original listed price.

Benefits of these changes:

- Enhanced market transparency and trust.
- Improved decision-making for buyers and sellers.
- Faster access to critical market information for all stakeholders.
